Which Gili Are You?

A 10-minute boat ride from the mainland of Lombok are the three gilis (islands), Gili Air, Meno and Trawangan. Each offers coral reefs for snorkeling and scuba, but Meno has the underwater love statues, which bring the crowds.

Crystal Vercoe from House of Travel says it was great to see them, but to manage expectations she adds that it was 'people soup'. Her tips for clients: "Do it early as it gets busier-but I enjoyed the snorkeling at Gili Air; lots of fish and even a turtle," she says. Gili Meno is the smallest and suits couples and honeymooners, and Air caters to all markets, with its laid back, quiet appeal. Trawangan is the largest with a 7km circumference and is 'party town'. There are more resorts away from the centre that suit families and couples looking for relaxation, yet nightlife close by.

Agents on the famil were taken back by the attention to detail at the resort. Guests can select their own room fragrance—sandalwood, lemongrass or peppermint—and boats pick up and drop off straight from the beach for gili tours. The family-friendly property can accommodate up to two adults and three children, but the majority of the time it's a couple's resort.

Getting There

Air New Zealand flies year-round to Bali operating five to seven flights per week between Apr and the end of Oct; three flights per week for travel from Nov to mid-Feb; and two flights per week mid-Feb until the end of Mar. Services are operated by Air NZ's leased 777 aircraft as well as NZ's 787-9 Dreamliner. The operating aircraft type can be identified in the GDS via their designators of 777 and 78N, adds NZ.

The Girls Of The Gilis



No cars can be found on any of the three gilis (islands), Gili Air, Meno and Trawangan; it's all horse-drawn carts, bikes or walking.

Apart from water sports—snorkeling, scuba and surfing-the shopping is pretty good, says First Travel Group's Toni Paltridge (pictured). Pearl farms are dotted in bays around Lombok and fixedprice shops and street sellers have an abundance of the ocean treasures. "I struggle with bargaining, but the prices are reasonable to start with. If you are happy with the price, that's what matters," she says.

Beachfront Living



Lombok's Living Asia Resort is located a 15-min drive from the tourist hub of Senggigi Beach. The beachfront property features a pool overlooking the ocean, large restaurant and bar area, spa and a dive centre with daily departures to the nearby Gili Islands.
